Post-operative advices : Knee

Arthromeniscectomy

Bandages

You may take the bandages off 3 days after your surgery.

Shower

You may shower as soon as the bandages are taken off.

Stitches

You don't have any stitches; the wound will close by itself in the first days following your surgery.

Physiotherapy

You must begin physiotherapy treatments 3 days after your surgery.

Weight

You will have crutches for the first 3 days. You may, however, walk on your operated leg if the pain is tolerable.

Follow-up appointment

You will have an appointment with your surgeon 4 to 6 weeks after your surgery. We will contact you to set this appointment.

ACL

Bandages

You may take the bandages off 3 days after your surgery.

Shower

You may shower as soon as the stitches are taken off.

Stitches

You must have the stitches taken off at a CLSC, 10 days after your surgery.

Physiotherapy

You must begin physiotherapy treatments 3 days after your surgery.

Weight

You must never put any weight on your operated leg. You will use crutches for all movements; the physiotherapist will decide when you may stop using them and when you may start putting weight on your operated leg.

Follow-up appointment

You will have an appointment with your surgeon 4 to 6 weeks after your surgery. We will contact you to set this appointment.
